



Coaching Certification / License Reimbursement Policy

Ottawa South United Soccer Club (OSU) and the Force Academy supports the ongoing development of its coaches at all levels and provides educational support to its coaches in a variety of forms. The club covers either partial or full cost of coaching course fees, as outlined in the policy document below

Travel, accommodation and other miscellaneous costs incurred in relation to coaching courses are not paid or reimbursed by OSU.

This document serves as general policy with regards to the financial support provided to OSU coaches as it relates to the coaches' continuing professional coaching development.

What is Funded and what is not funded by OSU?

Funded:

Coaching License courses that culminate in mandated OSA / CSA coaching accreditations.

Not Funded:

The club will not fund any license renewal fees or mandatory certifications such as Respect in Soccer (RIS) , Making Ethical Decisions (MED), etc.. This certification is the responsibility of the coach as part of the conditions of coaching an OSU competitive team.

Note:

OSU Coaches seeking to register for an eligible coaching license course must send an email in advance of the course to the Club Technical Director requesting approval for the coach to register for the particular course. The email must include the course / license level, date of course, location and cost of the course.

In addition, the coach must download the Coaches License Reimbursement agreement, sign it and provide to the club Technical Director prior to registering for any course / license.

The Club will not reimburse any coaching license fees under any circumstances with out the signed agreement and the technical directors approval in writing (email)
